- **Service Providers:** Third-party providers who assist us in operating our databases, Apps, website, and delivery of services, bound by confidentiality agreements.

4. Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. However, no method of transmission over the Internet or electronic storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

5. Your Rights
